## **64 dollar question, 64 thousand dollar question** (pytanie za 100 punktów)

Any crucial question or issue. Originally, the top question in "Take it or Leave it" a US radio game show (1941 to 1948).

**big one** (tysiąc dolarów)

1000 dollars.

**bill** (banknot; sto dolarów)

Paper currency, a dollar bill. Sometimes it means a 100 dollar bill.

**bit** (moneta)

12½ cents. Possibly because early Spanish peso coins could be divided into eight real pieces. (i.e. The "Pieces of eight" beloved by pirates and buccaneers.)

buck (dolec)

A dollar.

check (rachunek; czek bankowy)

In American English, a check means a restaurant bill, and also a check in the bank (which is spelled "cheque" in British English. In USA you settle a check with bills (i.e. dollar bills) but in UK you pay your bills with a cheque.

C-note (banknot studolarowy)

100 dollars. Also just "C".
